A RARE BOOK

This work may be described as an authorized version of certain of the sacred hymns of the Sikh scriptures. It is the fruit of the joint labors of the most distinguished contemporary Sikh theologians and scholars. The contents comprise selections mainly from the Adi Granth, generally regarded as the greatest work of Sikh literature, of which the principal authors were Guru Nanak and Guru Arjan.

This book was previously published in the UNESCO collection of representative works. This new edition published in 1998 co-published by UNESCO and Orient Longman, is in the commemoration of the tercentenary of the Khalsa. It was part of UNESCO's 'Major Project' for furthering mutual appreciation of the cultural values of East and West.
