This is a lavish, full color catalog that accompanied an art show organized by the Bradford Art Galleries and Museums in 1991. One of the first exhibitions devoted to bringing Sikh Art to the public, it was curated by Dr. Nima Poovaya-Smith, and the art was displayed at the Cartwright Hall Art Gallery. It included a large number of historic paintings, fabrics, jewelry, ornate weapons and suits of armor. Items came from many different collections, including the Royal Collection of Her Majesty the Queen, The India Office of Library and Records, the Victoria and Albert Museum, and numerous private collections. A contemporary painting by Aparna Caur was donated by the Vipasha Gallery in London.
